Your role at Wilderness Challenge

As OOS at Wilderness Challenge you may be assigned to many different parts of the camp. The area where help is most needed and where OOS are most commonly placed is program. Jobs in program require you to be at activities and assisting the “town mayor” with running the activity throughout the day. This can include such things as supervision, set up and maintenance of the town. Some other jobs may be assigned as help is needed. You will be required to work Friday, Saturday and Sunday (September 23-25, 2011).

Parking

There will be an assigned area for OOS parking when you arrive. You are required to park in this area. Your vehicle will not be allowed to leave this designated parking area until Sunday departure.

OOS Food Plan
